TO JOIN:

Go online to: horseshoepitching.com



Select JOIN (orange button) that comes up on the home page.

This will switch you to a new page that gives you the choice of Join or Renew. Click on the JOIN Button on the left side of the page.

A different page will come up, "Become an NHPA member". Type your name and personal information in the boxes. At the bottom of the page under "Charter" select Washington (if they reside in Washington State); under "Division" select the appropriate division; and under "Membership Type" select full.

On the right side click on Proceed to Payment and follow the instructions to pay the dues.

So how do you renew without having to call someone to do it for you?

RENEW:

Go online to: nhpa-eshoe.com

Your membership information and pitching statistics are stored in [eShoe](https://eshoe.com).

A box saying "Player Search" will come up. Type your name in the player search box and click on it. This will display your pitcher information.

To the right side of the card year line Click on [Renew](#).

Your payment information will come up, select payment method and pay.

OR

You can go online to: horseshoepitching.com

Select RENEW (blue button) that comes up on the home page.

This brings you to a page that gives you the choice of Join or Renew. Click on the [Renew](#) Button on the right side of the page.

The box saying "Player Search" will come up. Type your name in the player search box and click on it. This will display your pitcher information.

To the right side of the card year line click on [Renew](#) and pay.

It's that easy. You can even print a membership card or review your tournament stats (click on details).

HORSESHOE PRIDE

When I first started pitching, I remember the awe I had for the great names in our horseshoe organization – Henry Knauft, Ed Fischel, John Monasmith – they were always at the top of the lists. It was such a privilege to meet them and get to know them. To this day I still stand in awe of them.

Then in Bellingham I met Winnie Winetrout, Bill & Alice Van Egdon & Ken Elvig, and the stories of tournaments and games just flowed out of their memory banks. And it made me want to learn and improve so maybe one day my games would be talked about too!! We still talk about Peter Clark and his accomplishments.

And I remember sitting around at night after a tournament and listening to the music played by Frank Woods, Larry Lowitz, John Hensen and Bob Horner.....and Natalie danced! What happened to those times? I miss them.

I remember the great skits we've done through the years – like “Bessie’s Boil” (starring John Byfield), “School Days” (Misbehavior by Gene Kuiken), “The Operation” and the “Mock Wedding”. Talents unknown were unleashed and we felt like we belonged to something very special. We laughed till we cried.

I wonder if our membership numbers have anything to do with the way we look at our “hero’s” and how much we care about the people and history that formed our sport. Do we really take pride in belonging to this organization or is it just something for us to do on a Saturday?

I know our world has changed and our lifestyles have changed. Families are scattered and so much more is offered to fill our spare moments. The by-gone days of families doing most everything together are gone – as is the day of the horseshoe tournament – the whole day. Now we rush off as soon as we're done pitching because we have other things to do.

I would strongly encourage our new members and our youth to research this sport. Check out the Hall of Fame trailer, find out about the Wall of Fame people, read the history of the W.S.H.P.A. and ask some of our ‘old timers’ the stories they can tell. They would be delighted to know you are interested.

As the years tick away, time has taken its toll. Many of our friends are gone and their stories are lost. Let's strive to preserve as much as we can. Sit down with a seasoned pitcher and LISTEN! I guarantee you will hear some incredible tales to pass on to future generations. Let's rekindle that old fashioned passion. Let's be proud of horseshoes and the people it represents. It represents YOU!
