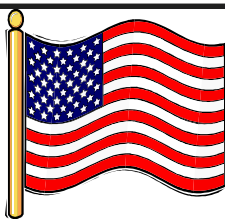

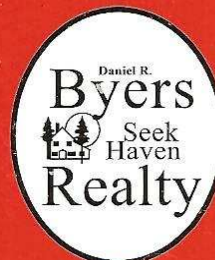

will someday be a World Champion". Peter became a person to watch at every tournament after that.

Sometime in the nineties, life's path took Peter in a direction that didn't include horseshoe pitching.

To many stalwarts of our game, Peter's absence from tournament play was a huge disappointment. He was the only serious contender in the State with youth on his side and with the ability to give top contenders of our game serious challenge. He was the 'future' of Horseshoe Pitching in WA.

But, his "horseshoe family" understood. Knowing that 'living life' can take youngsters on different paths, our interests turned to other youngsters of our game and "gone but not forgotten" was an apt phrase concerning Peter. A youth Hall of Fame was established, and Peter was the first inductee.

In a surprising event, packing a set of rusty old 'Allen' horseshoes Peter appeared unexpectedly at the Kitsap Tournament the 2nd. of July. The youthful lean figure that we remembered had filled out, but the mischievous grin was still there and after a few hello's, a few handshakes, a few hugs, Peter was seeded by TD Bonnie Clark, into Class A. Once again he was pitching with the best pitchers in the Northwest. Welcome Back Peter.
