### Commentary: *Jim Link,*

I had the pleasure of traveling to the Lakefair Open tournament at Olympia for the first time in several years. The Olympia courts hold a special place for me being the place where I pitched my first tournament in 1990. Mike Thornily qualified me at 7% and his remark "you'll probably lose a lot of games today" still stays with me. Although I pitched in several tournaments the remainder of that year I never won a game. I won my first class patch at Olympia several years later in my first playoff game. At that first tournament I pitched Jean Smith. At this tournament I pitched Jean Covington, who is the same person. She and I have pitched against each other in games all the way up to Class A, and now we're pitching in the 30's in Class C. Reminds us of what some of the old timers said, "be kind to others on your way up, you'll meet them again on the way down".

**World** is in session in Knoxville KY. No results to report yet, but that we can view results almost immediately on the internet speaks to the interest of horseshoe pitchers everywhere. We'll be watching.

**World** next year is coming back to the West. It will be in St. George, Utah which has a unique world horseshoe

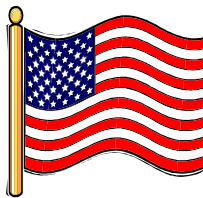

pitching tournament history. It was the site of ten consecutive World Tournaments from 1949 through 1959. Henry Knauff finished 11th. in 1959, 19th. in 1953. Ed Fishel finished 12th. In 1955. There are several other familiar Northwest names...Chapelle, Vickie (Chapelle) Winston, West, in the championship classes listed for those years, when horseshoe pitching was in its heyday.

Results are coming in for day I of pitching in Knoxville, after the first 5 games John McCarthy is 3/2, and Darrell Coulson is 2/3. John McCarthy III stands at 4.5/0.5. The McCarthy Jr.s will begin pitching @ 7:00PM on Aug 1. Patrick is seeded #1 in his class @ 37% far above the next competitor at 21%. That will be an exciting class for WA pitchers, as will Russ Phillips in the elders, who is seeded @ 87% with the next competitor at 81%.

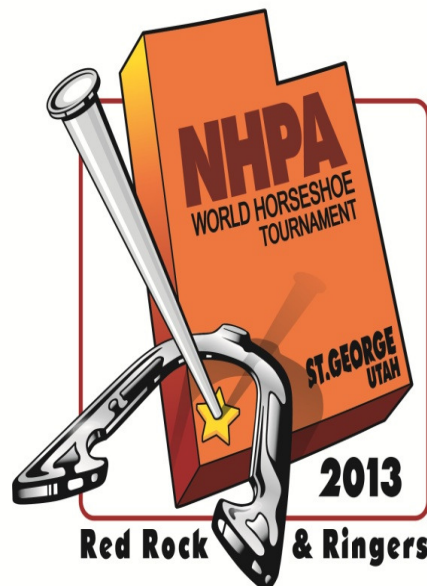

**Qualifying Events** – All adult entrants to the World Tournament who reside in the United States must have completed at least four (4) NHPA sanctioned events at their Division pitching distance during the twelve (12) months preceding the cut-off date listed on the current World Tournament entry form. **Note:** Only one event is required for Juniors.

**Exemptions** – An exception to the requirement of four (4) sanctioned events shall be active-duty members of the U.S. Armed Forces and their immediate family (if married), provided they meet the other eligibility requirements. Entering averages for foreign entrants and active-duty members of the U.S. Armed Forces and their immediate family, not in the NatStats database, will be verified by other means. (See RULE 11, Section D.1)
