pitching tournament history. It was the site of ten consecutive World Tournaments from 1949 through 1959. Henry Knauft finished 11th. in 1959, 19th. in 1953. Ed Fishel finished 12th. In 1955. There are several other familiar Northwest names...Chapelle, Vickie (Chapelle) Winston, West, in the championship classes listed for those years, when horseshoe pitching was in its heyday.

Results are coming in for day I of pitching in Knoxville, after the first 5 games John McCarthy is 3/2, and Darrell Coulson is 2/3. John McCarthy III stands at 4.5/0.5. The McCarthy Jr.s will begin pitching @ 7:00PM on Aug 1. Patrick is seeded #1 in his class @ 37% far above the next competitor at 21%. That will be an exciting class for WA pitchers, as will Russ Phillips in the elders, who is seeded @ 87% with the next competitor at 81%.
