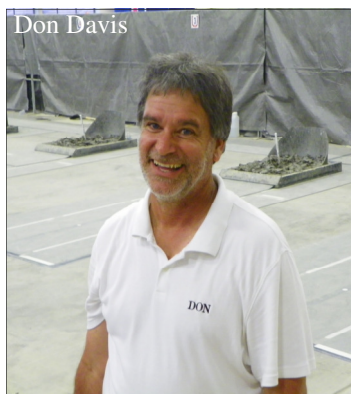

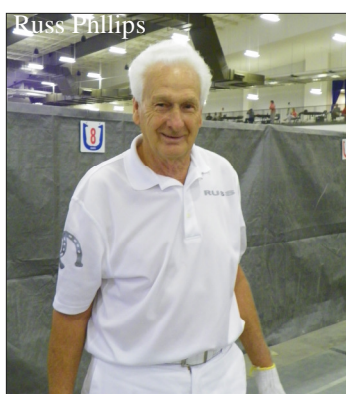

Jerry touched my soul and his leaving has left an empty place in my heart.

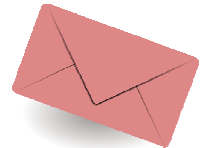
His light may have dimmed in our midst but we know it is shining so much brighter in the heavenly realm. Goodbye dear friend, you will be greatly missed.
