2024 World Tournament Thoughts and Wrap-up

As I sit here in my hotel room starting to write this wrap-up I think back to the Wednesday prior to the Tournament when Bonnie and I drove the 4.5 hours to Kennewick, Washington. The site of the 2024 World Horseshoe Tournament.

We were heading that way early and planned to help set-up the venue and we planned to pitch and then help with the tear down after it was over. This is the first time doing this and the amount of hours it takes to set-up is really something. To see the venue basically empty when we arrived on Wednesday afternoon to being completely set-up by Friday evening so that on Saturday they would be ready for the Warm-up tournament. This has two purposes, the first is to check the operations of all the computers that are used for score keeping to make sure they are in working order and communicating with the server that maintains all the data. The second is to work the clay so that when pitching starts officially on Monday that it is in the best condition possible. Bonnie helped with court set-up and different parts of the venue set-up as well and I predominately helped get all the monitors and computers set-up in both buildings. As of Friday evening the venue was totally set-up waiting for the pitchers to arrive.

Saturday we judged and kept score for the warm-up tournament and helped out where ever was needed for fine tuning, then on Sunday I judged for the second warm-up tournament which was a bracket style and Bonnie and Natalie opened up the Hall of Fame trailer and got it set-up since Phyl was unfortunately not able to make it.

There was a great need for scorekeepers and judges during the whole tournament, so what did we do? Bonnie kept score as needed when not pitching and I was judging during the first 3 days. She then continued to keep score and help out where ever needed. During my time pitching I was just trying to recoup from the prior 7 days, probably walked more than 30 miles total helping set things up and kept score for one shift, so that when I pitched I was in the best form I could be. During the whole tournament turns, mostly Bonnie and Natalie, were taken to open and sit with the HOF Trailer and answer any questions other pitchers or spectators had to the best of our knowledge as they stopped by to look through it.

Then on Sunday NHPA Council held the Delegate meeting, in the afternoon was the church service for those that wanted to attend, and that evening the Hall of Fame Banquet was held as usual.

Starting at 8am Monday the 5th we proceeded to tear down and by noon or so on Tuesday the 6th everything was broken down, cleaned, and packed up ready for transport to either storage, for some items, and the NHPA Trailer ready for it's trip to Salt Lake City where it will reside until we arrive there next year to set-up.

My take away is that it is an incredible undertaking to get things setup and to run the tournament. My suggestion is that if you are attending try to help where possible either score keeping a shift or two, taking the Judging class which they usually have a couple during the tournament and sign up to be a judge for a shift or two. This will do two things, first is that someone will not need to spend all their time scorekeeping or judging the whole tournament, and second it allows the shifts to start on time as long as the prior shift finishes when they should.

The following pages will show some of the pictures throughout the setup, tournament, and teardown. There are also some pictures of the different Washington pitchers and family that attended.

Any one that attended the WHT this year if you could write up some stories/experiences you had and send them to me I will include them in the September issue of the Shoes News. I am especially interested in those that attended their first World Tournament this year.

2024 Delegate Convention Report

NHPA Members,

The NHPA 2024 Delegate Convention has just completed with the following results:

NHPA President - Ben Webb - An additional proposal was made for this to be effective immediately, which also passed.

Ben's Vice President position is now open and applications are being accepted by sending them to Ben Webb and NHPA Newslite editor Blaine Scott. Applications will be accepted through the month of August with a deadline of August 31st. An appointment will then be made by the NHPA President.

NHPA 5th Vice president - Josh Olson

PBC 1 Summary: A charter is entitled to one delegate for being an active charter with the NHPA and an additional delegate for every 50 NHPA members.

Votes cast: 45

No: 3

Yes: 42

Passed - Total delegates per charter will be determined based on # of NHPA members

PBC 2 Summary: Candidates for NHPA office must announce candidacy no later than April 1st. Incumbents must announce by February 1st. No nominations will be accepted from the floor of the convention if they did not meet the submission deadline.

Votes cast: 46

No: 11

Yes: 35

Passed - No nominations accepted from the floor of the convention if they did not meet the submission deadline.

PBC 3 Summary: Proposal to change the decision location for the World Tournament future locations from the NHPA Executive Council to the members for a vote.

Votes cast: 50

No: 40

Yes: 10

Failed - Proposals for future World Tournament locations will continue to be determined by the NHPA Executive Council.

PBC 4 Summary: Proposal to change the deadline for submitting rules and bylaws changes from September 30th to February 1st of the voting year.

Votes cast: 49

No: 2

Yes: 47

Passed - Deadline for rules/bylaws changes was changed from September 30th to February 1st of the voting year.

PRC 1 Summary: Proposal to change the age for Cadets to be reduced from twelve (12) years old or younger to ten (10) years old or younger.

Votes cast: 53

No: 46

Yes: 7

Failed - Cadet age will remain at twelve (12) years old or younger for the entire calendar year.

PRC 2 Summary: Elder Women age 65 and older may pitch from any place on either the extended or full distance platforms and shall observe the twenty-foot (20') foul line.

Votes cast: 52

No: 6

Yes: 46

Passed: Elder Women age 65 and older may pitch from any place on either the extended or full distance platforms and shall observe the twenty-foot (20') foul line.

The NHPA Executive Council will be meeting to determine the effective dates of the rules if they are a different date than next year's pitching year.
