I went to the delegate meeting on Sunday and the two rule changes passed. One was for the pitching divisions for juniors and the other was for receiving credit in eshoes for pitching in tournaments. Both are listed here :

**RULE 1 - PITCHING DIVISIONS Section A - Juniors (See REQUIREMENT 6, for exceptions and additional information)**

1. Junior Boys (any male pitcher eighteen (18) years old or younger for the entire calendar year OR through September 30th of the year of completing high School - not to exceed 19 years of age) Junior Boys may pitch from any place on the extended or full-distance platforms. They shall observe the twenty-seven foot (27') foul lines. Note: Junior Boys may choose to move into the Open Men Division prior to the age guidelines, but cannot return to the Junior Boys, once this declaration has been made.
2. Junior Girls (any male pitcher eighteen (18) years old or younger for the entire calendar year OR through September 30th of the year of completing high School - not to exceed 19 years of age) Junior Girls may pitch from any place on the extended or full-distance platforms. They shall observe the twenty-seven foot (27') foul lines. Note: Junior Girls may choose to move into the Open Women Division prior to the age guidelines, but cannot return to the Junior Girls, once this declaration has been made.

### **Cont.**

**REQUIREMENT 2 - ALL NHPA TOURNAMENTS/ LEAGUES Section E - Tournament Credit** For all sanctioned events, a contestant must have pitched all their assigned games to receive eShoe credit. Exceptions: 1. If tournament is interrupted due to extenuating circumstances (e.g., weather, etc) and cannot be rescheduled and finished, credit is given for the games completed up to suspension of play. 2. Player forfeiture of an assigned game does not affect tournament credit (see Rule 11 section G Forfeits)

All officer re-elections ran unopposed, so no NHPA officer changes.

One notable is that next year, they will hold the world tournament as they have done for many years. No weekend stays to play for a championship.

**The thought and Idea behind this section, which I hope to have as an ongoing section, is to report news from the different clubs in our Association. Any club that has information they want to “spread the news” about just e-mail the editor with your write ups.**

As a reminder we only have a few tournaments left for the year. I would really like a great turn-out for the last tournament of the year here in Port Orchard. It will be a best 2 out of 3 to 21 points, double elimination style tournament. You will start by pitching 50 shoes to establish a ringer percentage, then will be placed into classes based on that percentage. You will then pitch the best 2 out of 3 to 21 points. If you win you will move on. If you lose you will then proceed to the losers bracket where you will need to work your way back to face the winner of the winners bracket. At this point you will need to beat them twice to win the class. Depending on the number of pitchers they will be 6 or 8 man classes. It would be great if we had all 8 man classes so we need 16, 24, 32 pitchers to make it a reality.
