You will be asked to show your shoes (2 pair) will be checked for weight and dimensions, your pick up tool, if you use one, must pass inspection, and your shirt will be checked to see it has your name and state on an appropriate shirt. Hopefully this helps you to be ready with all your necessary equipment. It's up to you to make all your other plans and reservations to make your visit to St. George an enjoyable experience.




