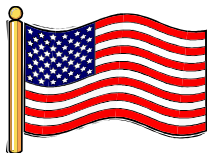

Time passes by – and in John Byfields case, way too fast. We hadn't heard all his jokes yet or experienced all his magic tricks yet. I think the jokes he told tickled him as much as the listener. And that made us laugh so much more.

I so well remember the first time I met John. It was at a horseshoe tournament in Tacoma. I was a brand new pitcher and just learning to keep score. John took the chair next to mine and said he'd help me. Then he said, "Did you hear about the job opening for a secretary?" I said no, and he said, 'well one gal applied who could type really fast, another gal applied who could take shorthand really fast, and another gal applied who wasn't too sharp but was really pretty. Who do you think got the job?' I said, I suppose the pretty one. John said, "None of those got the job, but the one with the big boobs did." And then he said, "I see you didn't qualify either!" And he laughed so hard he almost fell off his chair and I almost fell off mine too! That was my first encounter with John and I was endeared to him forever.

He started calling me 'Lil Darlin'. I said, I bet you call all the gals that and he said, 'No, No, only you'. But one time I was behind him and I caught him calling someone else that – and he just doubled over laughing when he saw I'd heard.

How we loved him. I know most of you have your own stories to cherish. John enlivened a room and brought a smile to everyone he encountered. He was a very special giant of a man. Not just in size of stature but in size of spirit and heart. We shall miss him so much.

John – this is your 'Lil Darlin' signing off one last time.

Natstats

I received this email from Gail Sluys this morning. Thank you to Gail for keeping us all up to date.

All

I have spoken to Julie and Vickie - Glenn and Shirley's daughters and the news is very bad. They will be taking Glenn off of life support either tonight or tomorrow as there is no brain activity. There have been no decisions yet as to services or any other information I can give you at this time. I will get information to you as soon as I get it.

Gail

Yesterday I sent out a notice asking you to instruct your tournament directors and statisticians to hold all correspondence to natstats until a replacement is established. Well, I have another thought on that.

Whoever takes this job is going to have a pile of accumulated workload. If a file is sent to him from an HSMaster program, the file can be imported in seconds. What I'm asking every charter president and Regional Director to do is work together in your charter to find and establish a charter statistician. All tournament results within your charter should be sent to this person, and he/she would prepare the results to send to natstats, in an HSMaster file.

I realize that this may not be achievable in many charters, at least not on short notice, but we have to try. HSMaster is not rocket science, it's very easy to use once you learn it. So if your charter has a statistician that performs these functions, fantastic. I know this system works smoothly in MN. Your statistician can work to get all of your tournament directors to learn and use HSMaster at their tournament and have these files prepared already.

If you do not have a charter statistician, and cannot/will not establish one, then I ask that you find someone that can at least convert some or all of the tournament results you're piling up into an HS Master file. I would estimate that it takes about 15-30 minutes to enter in a fair size tournament into the program, depending on how proficient you are at the keyboard.

These are my thoughts and requests to all of you today. Let's pull together and take something positive from the tragedy with Glen Jamieson. And let's try to make this transition as efficient as we can. More info coming soon, so please watch your email daily. Thank you

Ed: For those who aren't familiar, Glenn Jamieson was NHPA's natstats guy. Natstats and the Stats at "WORLD" are done with a program developed by Walter Ray Williams. When a charters stats are done on HS Master as Debi does them for the WSHPA, they are very easily massaged into Walters program. Without Glenn's many years of experience, Stats at World will be a challenge for whoever steps up to take on the job.

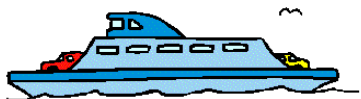

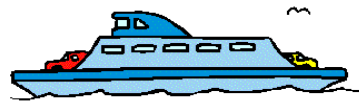


