### Commentary: *Jerry Clark*

**J**uly 18, 2015. If you are a horseshoe pitcher, remember that date. What is the significance of that date you ask? ESPN, the world wide leader in sports broadcasting, will be broadcasting live for three hours that day from the site of the 2015 World Horseshoe Tournament in Topeka, Kansas. With programming that will include pitcher interviews, and pitching demonstrations from some of the top performers in our game, our sport will receive long overdue exposure to millions of people worldwide, who have probably never even heard of horseshoes.

In the May 2014 issue of Shoes News, I wrote an article entitled "I Can Dream...Can't I?" It concerned this very topic, of how big an impact it would be if we could get television involved with our world tournament. For the first time we will be showcasing the very best of our game to people from all over the United States and around the world. Let's hope it's compelling enough television that the ESPN executives decide to televise from the World Tournament every year. If that happens, it is almost inevitable that the growth of horseshoe pitching worldwide, will exceed anything we could have imagined. When that growth happens, it will be the job of our charters, and also we as

individuals, to keep this new influx of people and momentum going, so we can take full advantage of this new awareness of our game.

As the stars of horseshoe pitching get “face time” on camera, the opportunities of advertising and promotion of not only themselves and their personalities, but also the sport, will surely follow. Thankfully we have star power in our sport. Pitchers like Alan Francis, Brian Simmons, Walter Ray Williams, Joan Elmore, and Sue Snyder and many others. They are probably some of the main reasons that ESPN is coming to Topeka. When ESPN leaves, let’s hope they have many more reasons for wanting to make this an annual part of their broadcasting schedule.

Another great benefit to us, is the timing of our World Tournament. It usually takes place between mid July to early August. During this time of the year professional basketball and hockey are over. The NFL and college football haven’t started up yet, and baseball is in mid-season. What I’m saying is that sports in general are in a slow period, and this gives us a great opportunity to grab peoples attention.

The timing looks to be perfect, the question to us is, are we, as the NHPA, ready to seize the moment, even if it disrupts our normal routines and the things we’ve grown accustomed to? We want our game to become relevant and grow don’t we? I believe this is our one big moment, and we must seize it with all we have, it may not come around again.

We look at our meager averages, and wonder if it’s worth the effort, and sometimes seriously doubt if we can ever match their skills. Since our sport places us in classes according to our ringer percentage, we can be a champion regardless of our ringer percentage. All that said, here is an interesting fact. Did you know that 50% of all sanctioned horseshoe pitchers, average less than 31% ringers? The chart below was in a World Tournament newsletter in 1996 at Gillette, Wyoming, and was printed in the Feb. 1997 Shoes News.
