Shoe Check-in at the Dixie Center, St. George

Your first day of competition starts with arriving 1-1/2 hour ahead of your start time. Shoe check-in, last minute instructions, and class pictures start the procedure. After this you will be given plenty of time to warm-up and get ready to pitch. So, what all should you have to get ready for this?

You will be asked to show your 2017 membership card, your horseshoes (2 pair) will be checked for weight and dimensions, your pick up tool, if you use one, must pass inspection, and your shirt will be checked to see it has your name and state on an appropriate shirt. You






