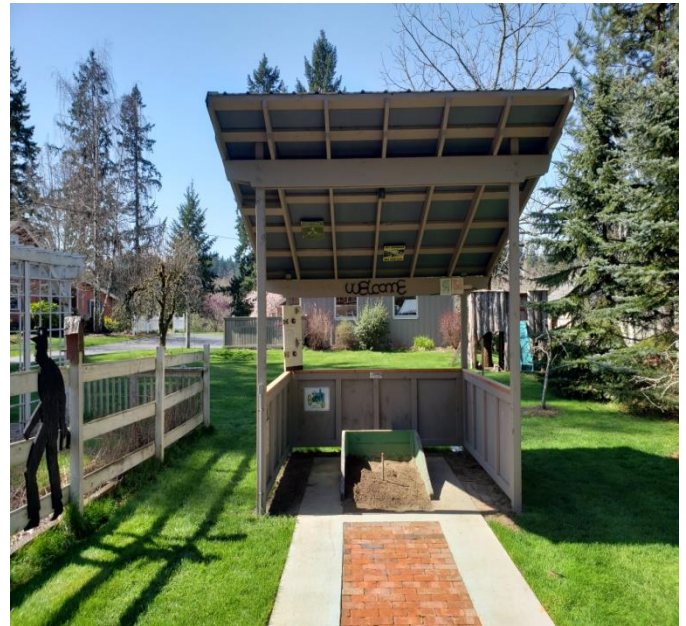

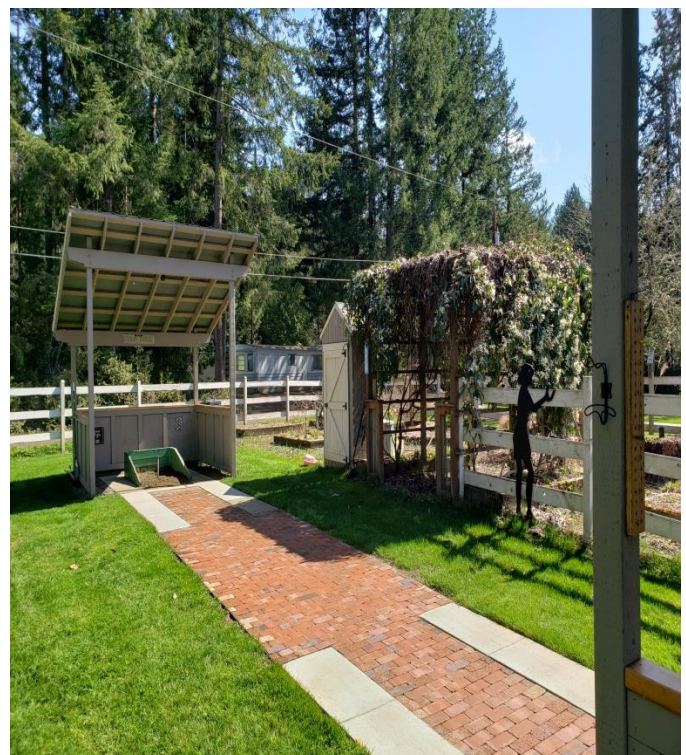

“The NHPA remains committed to providing a safe environment for our members while also providing competitive opportunities to pitch horses. Across the nation, Charters have had to cancel sanctioned tournaments, thus affecting members trying to qualify for the 2020 World Tournament in Monroe, LA as a result of the COVID-19 virus. The NHPA Council has extended the registration deadline to June 1st and reduced the qualifying tournaments from four to two, which allows pitchers the best opportunity to qualify for the World Tournament.”

While "real" sports are put on hiatus, sporting leagues are trying to gain footing in the digital world. However, one league had already made digital their home back in 2018.

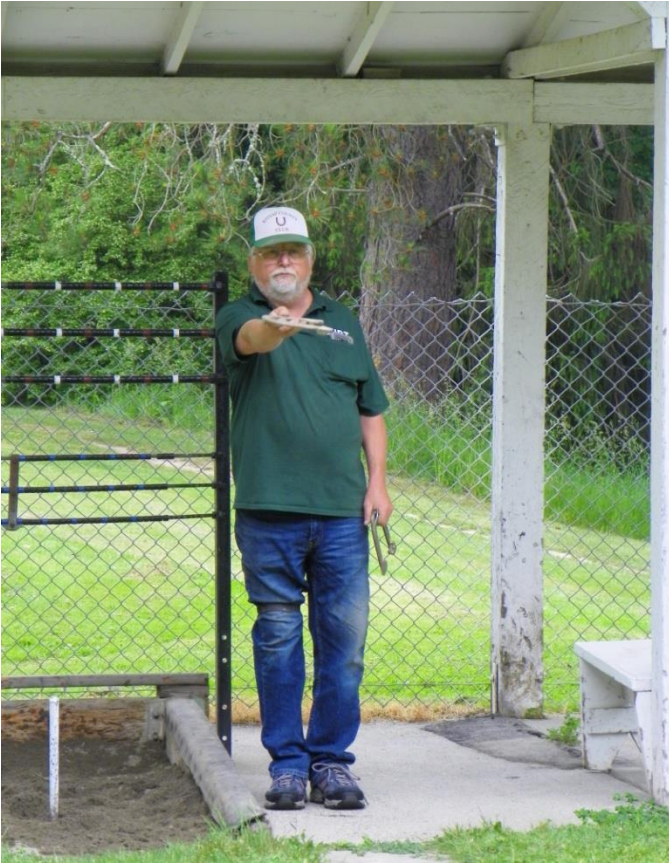
The Facebook group Horeshoe Pitching Online was created by enthusiasts in Salt Lake City, Utah back in Dec. 2018.

The most ringers scored by an individual female player in a Horseshoe Pitching World Championship game is 126 by Sylvianne Moisan (Canada) in 2008. Alan Francis is a horseshoes pitcher from Defiance, Ohio. He has won the World Horseshoe Championship 24 times, in 1989, 1993, 1995–1999, 2001, 2003–2010 and 2012–2019. That is the most anyone has won it (2nd place belongs to Ted Allen who has won 10).
