"The NHPA remains committed to providing a safe environment for our members while also providing competitive opportunities to pitch horses. Across the nation, Charters have had to cancel sanctioned tournaments, thus affecting members trying to qualify for the 2020 World Tournament in Monroe, LA as a result of the COVID-19 virus. The NHPA Council has extended the registration deadline to June 1st and reduced the qualifying tournaments from four to two, which allows pitchers the best opportunity to qualify for the World Tournament."
