### **Hello Valley of the Sun Players**

The 65<sup>th</sup> annual Valley of the Sun tournament is over. Some players will say it was the worst weather they have played in; some will say the weather was perfect and they would all be correct. Tuesday started cold and very windy, by the afternoon it got worse, we could only get three and a half games in out of five before it started raining. Wednesday was a little better but still cold. Ground crews had to suck water out of the pits with a vacuum. Pits were muddy, sprinkling dry clay on the wet clay helped a little. Thursday started with a 36-degree temperature and windy but warmed to the high 50's before the day was done. Friday was not to bad warming to the mid 60's. Saturday no clouds and Sunday some clouds were typical Arizona weather about 57 degrees in the morning and reaching in the middle 70's by mid-day.

We had 122 players in 12 classes this year and a lot of new players from 20 different states and Canada with players as low as 6% and as high as 84%. Only our bottom class was handicapped with a spread of 6% to 19%. We had several playoffs for First place. Jacob Fimbres beat Matt Fuller in a playoff for first place in Men's A class giving him his 6<sup>th</sup> Valley of the Sun tournament victory. Marlene Ray won class A-30 and J.D. Drake won A Elders. B 30 had a firstplace tie which should have had a playoff. However, Clarence Jellema president of the EVHC club decided not to play. It is amazing he did so well, he is usually first at the pits before sunrise getting donuts on the way and then getting courts ready and then judging during the day. This is amazing for a person in their 80's, so the victory in the oldest NHPA sanctioned tournament went to Cadet Tom Grose the youngest player to win a class in the Valley of the Sun tournament. Another playoff was in Women's C, Jan Kaub from CO was ahead with 10 shoes left, but Nora Lindbo WA came back and won. The other playoff was in E Elders with Bruce Reid AZ beating George Green WA for the win. Attached are the complete results of the tournament and a few pictures. We were also honored to have Jim Kinney NHPA Sec/Treas. Barbara Carson 4<sup>th</sup> VP and Josh Olson 5<sup>th</sup> VP present this year for our tournament. Special thanks to Russ Watkins OR (assistant TD) Mary Fimbres AZ for organizing concessions Shirley Sprague IA check in Chris Jordan IA, Patti Lopez-Cepero AZ pictures and many many score keepers from AZ, TN, OR, MI, MO, IA, and some I do not know which states they were from. All of this was organized to the highest level which made the event a memorable one.

We also had hotel problems this year with prices. We hit an odd year where we had a Super Bowl and the Phoenix Open golf tournament in the same week. On Monday of last week 200,000 people flew out of Sky Harbor Airport, their busiest day ever. That does not include about 1,000 privet jets and planes leaving. One upscale home on Camelback Mountain rented for \$250,000 for just one week. To get away from these events we may move next years tournament to February 27 thru March 3. We are going to discuss this at our next East Valley Horseshoe Club meeting. This still does not guarantee better weather but ups the odds for it. This year in Arizona we have had lots of rain and snow and it is going to rain and snow again starting Tuesday night thru Sunday. So, I guess you could say we were lucky to even get the tournament in this year. I hope to see many of you again at this years World Tournament.



If you're a practicing Christian, the Easter season may mean planning when to attend church services for the important dates leading up to the holiday, such as Ash Wednesday.

Traditionally, Christians (and Catholics, in particular) observe <u>the 40 days of Lent</u>, which starts on Ash Wednesday. Ash Wednesday is the time when you may finally decide on <u>what you want to give up for</u> <u>Lent</u>, or perhaps it's an opportunity to spend a quiet moment on some <u>Easter prayers</u>.

"It's day 1 of a new beginning; a better more virtuous you will exist in 40 days!" says Benjamin Gibson, a published author who teaches Sunday school with a focus on sacrament preparation. You can also mark the day by considering trying a new better habit. "Maybe you will volunteer more? Pick a charity that needs help," he suggests.

No matter how you choose to observe, the most important part of the day Like Easter, the exact timing of Ash Wednesday changes each year. Every year, it falls 40 days before Easter. In 2023, Ash Wednesday will be on Wednesday, February 22. That's pretty early in the year, especially considering it was March 2 in 2022.
