Economic downturn anyone? Economic concerns (primarily fuel costs) are impacting tournament numbers across the state. To drive 200 miles to attend a tournament is to lay out \$60 or \$70 bucks in fuel. Unless you can share those costs by carpooling, driving that distance to a tournament is almost prohibitive.

There has been concern among those who love this game of a demise in numbers, at tournaments, due in part to rising fuel costs. For that reason, it was suggested that tournaments be held on both sides of the mountains on the same weekend in the summer to accommodate those who would go to a tournament if it was within a reasonable distance.

The tournament schedule looks pretty barren for the month of July. There are no tournaments scheduled for the weekend of the fourth which falls on a Friday this year. That is a big weekend in Goldendale. It is the weekend of the "Community days" celebration with parades, the demolition derby at the fairgrounds, a Classic Car show downtown, a fun filled small town weekend. It could be a time when horseshoe pitchers from around the Northwest could come together to have an event to explore how we can bring our game to future generations in a way that will 'hook' them like we've been 'hooked'. I thought you might want to communicate to all Washington pitchers the new plate system for the state of Oregon (OHPA). I wish I would have got it out to you before the April tournament in Hermiston, but here it is - thanks for your help ahead of time!

OREGON (OHPA) HAS NEW PLATE SYSTEM

In the past Washington horseshoe pitchers traveling to Oregon tournaments could expect the 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place awards plates in the envelopes with their monetary awards. In our 2007 state meeting the decision was made to wait until after the tournaments to have the plates produced. Oregon tournament directors have been instructed to get mailing addresses from any out of state pitchers who earn these plates so we can later mail them. Washington pitchers can help this process by providing their mailing address before they leave the tournament. Class winners will still receive the 1st place patch at the tournament site in their awards envelope. 




