he Annual Meeting produced several changes in the way the WSHPA will be doing business in 2011. There will be a dues increase with the Shoes News portion of the WSHPA dues going from \$10 to \$20 a year. Margaret Byfield is stepping down after serving 25 years as treasurer for the WSHPA. She will be replaced by Rhonda Davis. Vey Allen will be retiring as Regional Director with Vic Magnus stepping into that position; HOF committee chair for 2011 will be Harold Boyer; Monty McLaughlin was voted in as 3rd. Vice President replacing Larry Getts. The State Doubles Tournament will be held in Kennewick, and State Singles will be in Olympia.

Don Davis, Carol Sperber, Russ Phillips and Kaiti Reeves retained their titles in their respective classes with J. T. McCarthy IV replacing Matt Fuller as the new Jr. Boys Champion.

Top Tournament Pitcher of the Year went to Orlean Clinton. Phyl Quist presented an Honor Roll Award Plaque to a surprised Gary Fuller for the constant encouragement and coaching through the years that has gotten his son Matt to the top of the world juniors, and for his knack of "talking horseshoes" wherever he goes. Paul Tutewiler reminded us that this award is available for someone who does something "a little above and beyond" – not necessarily a horseshoe pitcher. Nominations need to be sent in by May 1. Sparks' Award – Don and Rhonda Davis presented their horseshoe napkin holder and trivet – ideas by Rhonda, welding by Don.

Ray DeBoer, Burlington, and Bob Hoerner, Tacoma were this year's inductees into the Hall of Fame. Don't forget that HOF nominations are also due on May 1. Harold Boyer is the HOF chairman for 2011. Send him your nomination. His address is in the officers directory on Page 2 of Shoes News.

WSHPA Executive Board Meeting Minutes, 9-4-10

At Spokane State Tournament

The meeting was called to order by President Don Davis. The minutes of the previous Executive Board meeting were read and approved.

Treasurer's Report: Read by Treas. Margaret Byfield, and approved.

August 2009-July 2010 Beginning Balance: \$5565.19 Received 19,602.20 Expenses 20,547.22

Current Balance \$4,620.17 Bank of America Savings: \$7,690.55 Jr. Fund Detail: \$4882.25

Money Mkt. Scholarship Fund: \$6383.52 CD Accounts (WA Fed): \$63,729.88 Horseshoes (62pr. + 7 sets): \$3,680.00

Horseshoe Notions: \$1787.85

<u>Budget for 2011:</u> Presented by Treas. Margaret. Gene Kuiken moved to accept the budget. It was seconded and approved. President Don praised Margaret for her 25 years of service as WSHPA Treasurer. He has appointed Rhonda Davis as the new treasurer. She is very experienced and well-qualified for this appointment.

Committee Reports

Promotions: Chairman Jon Turnbull reported an application for \$4000 from a fund provided by the city of Burlington that is designed to bring people in to use hotels, shops, and restaurants. If the money is granted he will propose a sanctioned money tournament.

Debi McRae has gotten tavern league pitchers to come and practice with the Skagit club on Tuesdays. Two of them have joined the club. Jon recommends other clubs try this, and remind them that they can bring their families to our leagues.

Junior Promotions: Chairman Phyl Quist reported that the two Juniors who went to the World Tournament in Cedar Rapids were given \$600 each from the Junior World Fund to help with expenses. The auction this year brought in \$585. The balance in the fund is \$2443. She has appointed Matt Fuller, Kaiti Reeves, and Deanna Boyle to serve on the Jr. Auxiliary Committee. Kaiti Reeves will promote a horseshoe club at Eastern Washington University. There was no inductee into the Jr. Hall of Fame this year.

Hall of Fame: Chairman Vic Magnus reported that Harold Boyer will be the 2011 chairman. There will be two inductees this year.

Regional Director: Chairman Vey Allen distributed the proposed 2011 tournament schedule and asked each club to check it for accuracy regarding their tournaments. He asked that clubs bring any leftover patches to the Northwest at Yakima as the NHPA is short of patches. Vey is resigning as chairman and recommends Vic Magnus as his replacement.

Editor: Jim Link reported he will try to promote a separate fund or account where a reserve could be available, rather than using his own money for purchases. The purchases of horseshoes and notions could be included. A credit card account might be a workable way to do this.

Honor Roll: Vice-Pres. Paul Tutewiler said there was one submission this year. He would like to have more next year. Each club likely has someone, not necessarily a pitcher, who deserves a nomination.

World Tournament: Pres. Don said that Jim and Phyl Quist get there first and do much work. "They make us look good." Phyl reported that Joan Elmore and Alan Francis are the men's and women's champions this year. Our Matt Fuller is the Jr. World Champion! Nine people from Washington placed "in the money" at the tournament.

Phyl and Don were our delegates at the convention. It was a good meeting, without controversy. The 2011 World Tournament will be in Monroe, Louisiana, and in 2012 it will be in Knoxville, Tennessee. Phyl urges everyone to go to a World Tournament. "It's a great experience."

Phyl also announced that the NHPA has arranged that any Motel 6 will give a 10% discount if you say "horseshoes" and provide the necessary code (CP546320).

New Business

Dues Increase: Phyl Quist reported that we are losing money on the *Shoes News* right now. Last year \$989 was lost. She proposed raising the *Shoes News*' portion of the dues from \$10 to \$15. Gene Kuiken moved to do this. The motion was seconded. In the discussion that followed it was suggested to make it \$20. Gene changed his motion to \$20, thereby raising the total dues from \$37 to \$47. The motion was approved.

Names on Shirts: Paul Tutewiler reminded us that having our name on our shirt helps scorekeepers, it looks more professional, and gives us more respect when people see us in the parks, etc.

Tournament Possibilities: Vey Allen, Bob Hummel, and Jim Link have been discussing having a Northwest Doubles Tournament. Pres. Don said there has been some thought to having a Tri-State Team Championship.

Plaques and Plates: Phyl Quist needs to know if you don't want plaques or plates. She also said that the plates are sometimes picked up at the State Tournament, but don't get to the person intended. If she is asked to have a plate remade the cost will be \$3. **Credit Card Account:** Phyl Quist moved that the new Treasurer investigate this and make a recommendation. The motion was approved.




