The origin of Halloween can be traced to


Samhain the ancient Gaelic festival

(pronounced sow-in, which rhymes with (cow-in), meaning Summer's End. This festival celebrated the end of harvesttime and the beginning of the "dark half" of the year. It was a seasonal marker as the ancient Celts bid good-bye to warmth and light as day <u>length shortened</u>. The ancient Celts believed that the veil between the worlds of the living and the dead was at its thinnest during Samhain. This had positive benefits, as it was an ideal time to consider the dead, communicate with the deceased, and also to divine the future. However, the Celts also believed that some spirits (ghosts) could pass through the wall and damage their crops. To mark the event, people would build huge bonfires to burn crops.
