Kitsap Bracket Tournament

We had a great time at the first annual Kitsap bracket tournament. We had 15 players which went into two classes. Still working on getting into HS Master for upload into E-shoes. The following is how play was conducted.

Step 1: Show up and pay your entry fee.

Step 2: pitch 50 shoes to establish your entering ringer percentage.

At this point then I had to get that input into the spreadsheet. Sorted by percentage then placed into the two 8 man classes. Class A and Class B.

Step 3: the first round is played, best 2 out of 3 to 21 points. Winner proceeded forward and the loser went into the loser side of the spreadsheet.

Step 4: the rest of the rounds are played out as shown above.

Step 5: Once the winner bracket and the loser bracket winner is decided then they played for first and second place.

The spreadsheet on the following page shows how the brackets went.

Class A winner was Al Kettle form Oregon, Peter Clark was second, and Bob Sperber claimed third.

Class B winner was Larry Parsons, Stan Speers was second, and Fritz Obertz claimed third.

Larry Parsons came from the loser side of the spreadsheet and had to win 2 “best 2 of 3” matches to win.
