


WASHINGTON STATE SINGLES TOURNAMENT

Thoughts and Prayers



In Memory of Norman Hansen - September 3, 1927 - August

Norman Rollin Hansen was born in Richmond Beach, Washington on 9/3/27 as the middle child of five. His roots run deep – his father Rollin Hansen grew up on the same property that Norman did. This acreage was settled on, and tamed by, and built upon, by Norman's great-grandfather Morton Anderson in 1901.

Norman grew up as the middle child of five, playing horseshoes from an early age. His brother Bob Hansen was quite good at it. These two went to many NHPA championships around the Pacific Northwest. It took him a while, but he finally figured out his main problem: he said he's standing too close to the shoe after it lands.

Norman was the Treasurer of the Seattle Horseshoe Club for many years. He was a frequent tournament director and his sister-in-law Donna Hansen often provided lunch with sandwiches and delicious homemade cinnamon rolls.

He was an elementary school teacher in the Shoreline School District north of Seattle for 27 years. He moved to Lake Forest Park in 1973 and retired from teaching in 1985. He and Donna were snowbirds for the last 18 years that spent winters in her home in Mesa, Arizona. Norman recently authored "Stories of Richmond Beach" (Amazon) and "Stories of a Paratrooper in Occupied Japan" (to be published soon) and www.normanrhansen.com.

Norman Hansen died peacefully in his sleep on 8/17/2016 at age 88 from cancer. Sadly, he was the last remaining family member among his siblings and their spouses. He was passionate about collecting history on his family and the Shoreline community. For over twenty years he volunteered at, and contributed to, the Shoreline Museum along with recruiting several relatives who also provided even more volunteer work.
